We are a faith-based 501(c)(3) established in 2018. Our mission is to empower and support survivors and victims of domestic abuse in East Shelby County, Tennessee.

WHAT WE DO

Using a 24-month, vertical service model we educate up to 20 clients on how to gain economic independence and form healthy relationships, while stabilizing their families and strengthening their faith. Our direct services are available to women in six suburban communities of East Shelby County - Arlington, Bartlett, Collierville, Cordova, Germantown, Lakeland, Millington, and Rossville.

Through a holistic and relational approach, we support women healing from the emotional, mental, physical, and spiritual wounds caused by domestic abuse. With each client we focus on assisting, investing in, and mentoring them as they move forward.

- **Assisting** – Addressing the needs of women transitioning out of abusive relationships, requires delivering services that impact their lives in a positive way. Our services allow us to assist with childcare, job placement, food insecurity, counseling, legal representation, and housing instability.
- **Investing** – By intentionally investing in the overall well-being of our clients, we show the love of Christ. In this way, we can then partner with clients to develop a detailed plan that helps move them towards a more hopeful future. Not only for them, but also for their children.
- **Mentoring** – Through one-on-one mentoring, we foster the development of healthy and safe relationships. This requires committed volunteers, who consistently engage with our clients as a listening ear, a confidante, a prayer partner, or an encouraging friend during difficult days.
